

## Jackson Memorial Hospital Restricted Antimicrobial Approval Process

### Approvals for restricted antimicrobials may be given by the following:

- Infectious Diseases (ID) Consult
- Clinical Pharmacist
- On-Call Antimicrobial Stewardship (ASP) Pharmacist

### If approval has not been obtained, please follow the below process:

1. The ordering physician is to contact the ASP at 786-586-0607
2. Provide the below patient information:
  - a. Patient name, location, and MRN
  - b. Previous ID consults (if applicable)
  - c. Pertinent laboratory values and culture results
  - d. Restricted antimicrobial, dose, and indication for use
3. If a restricted antimicrobial is approved, ASP will contact the pharmacy for order verification and dispensing of the medication
4. In some complex cases, ASP may suggest a formal ID consult prior to approval
