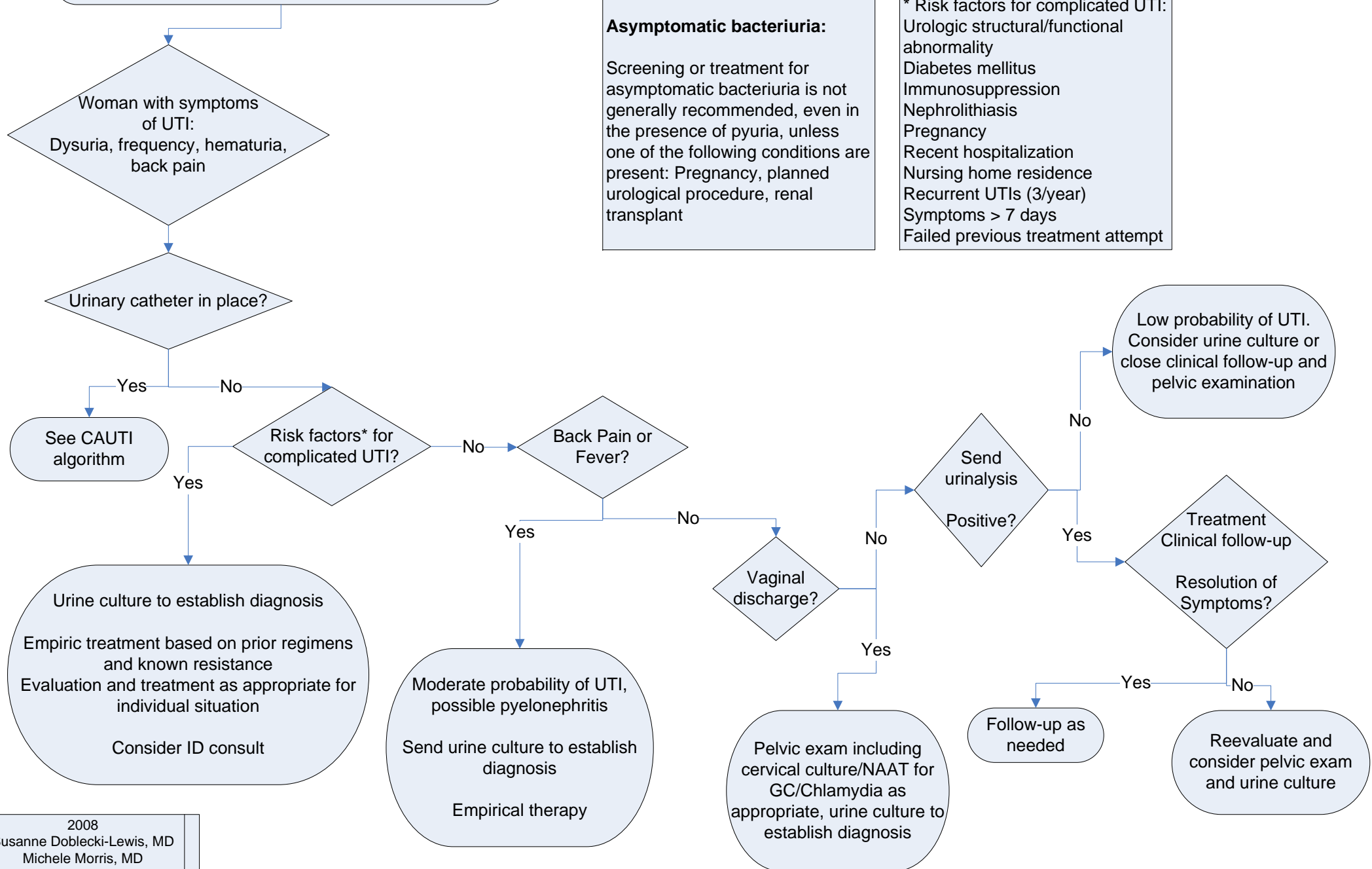


UTI in Women



Asymptomatic bacteriuria:

Screening or treatment for asymptomatic bacteriuria is not generally recommended, even in the presence of pyuria, unless one of the following conditions are present: Pregnancy, planned urological procedure, renal transplant

* Risk factors for complicated UTI:

- Urologic structural/functional abnormality
- Diabetes mellitus
- Immunosuppression
- Nephrolithiasis
- Pregnancy
- Recent hospitalization
- Nursing home residence
- Recurrent UTIs (3/year)
- Symptoms > 7 days
- Failed previous treatment attempt
